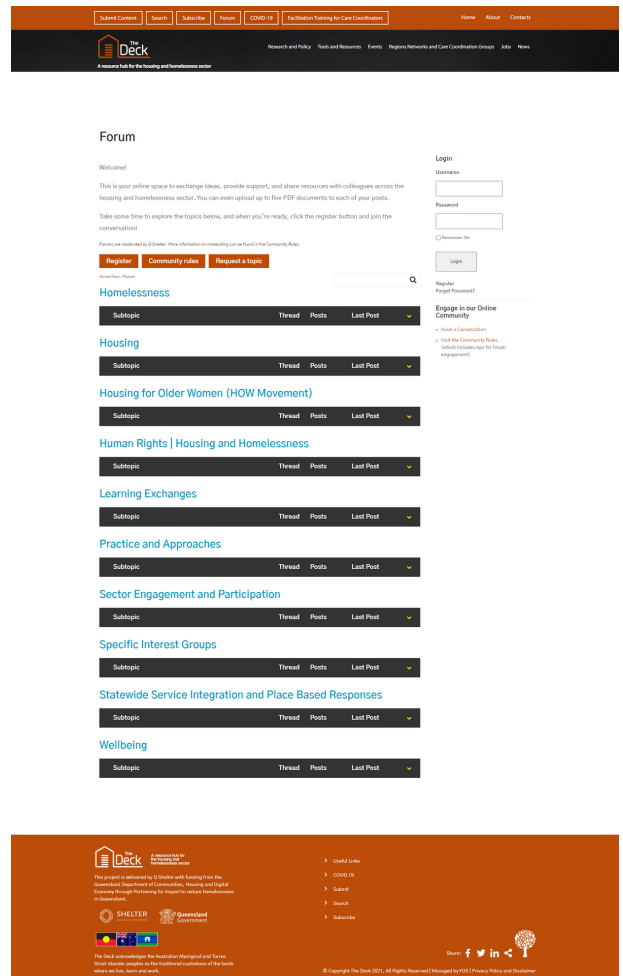


Getting started on the Forum on The Deck

The Forum is your online space to exchange ideas, provide support, and share resources with colleagues across the housing and homelessness sector.

1. To access the forum on The Deck go to: thedeck.org.au/forum
2. Read through the forum's [community rules](#)
3. Login or Register - to register click the orange 'register' button and complete the form to become a member of The Deck and to participate in the forum.
4. Once you are logged in you can explore the forum topics, a forum is organised into topics, subtopics and threads.
5. Click the grey bar below a topic to expand and see all subtopics
6. Click on a subtopic to see threads of conversation
7. You can post comments on a thread and upload up to 5 PDFs to each of your posts.
8. To subscribe to a topic and receive email notifications, click 'subscribe' in the top right corner.
