The nurse-led walk-in clinic can be accessed for walk-in, urgent treatment of conditions not anticipated to be life-threatening. The service is free for Medicare and non-Medicare Card holders.

The nurse-led walk-in clinic is not an emergency department. The safest and fastest way to access help in an emergency is to call 000.
