Temporary Refuge Shelter opening at RNA Showgrounds

5 March 2025

A temporary refuge shelter will be open from **7am Thursday 6 March** at the **RNA Showgrounds** in **Bowen Hills** for residents needing to leave their properties due to the impacts of Tropical Cyclone Alfred.

The Refuge Shelter will be a short-term facility designed to protect people during the predicted peak wind period of Tropical Cyclone Alfred and is a place of last resort. Keep an eye on the

The Refuge Shelter will open from **7am Thursday 6 March 2025** and will accept residents up to **12pm**. After that time, the facility will be locked down.

The shelter will include only basic amenities and will not have beds, cooking facilities or catering.

Please bring non-perishable food and water if possible.

Council will continue to monitor the situation and keep you informed.

An evacuation centre is open at the **Logan Metro Sports and Events Centre (357 Browns Plains Road, Crestmead)** for those in need of emergency accommodation.

The centre is providing:

- Bedding
- Toilets and showers
- Food, tea and coffee
